It is therefore incredibly important that our pupils are aware that every message they send will form part of their digital footprint forever and cannot be removed, even if messages have been deleted. We would like to encourage all children to consider the feelings of their peers and think twice before sending any message online, in both private and group chats. We would also like to take this opportunity to remind parents of the importance of having regular conversations with your children about the online conversations that they are part of, as well as checking their devices regularly.
